



## River Islands Technology Academy 2019-2020 School Year Lottery/Admissions Information

If you are interested in having your child's name entered in a lottery for openings for the 2019-20 school year, please apply during the application window of January 30<sup>th</sup> -February 22<sup>nd</sup>. It does not matter if you apply on, February 6, February 15, or February 19; all names submitted during this window will be placed in the lottery on February 27<sup>th</sup>, for grades, where spaces are available.

**NOTE: We do not anticipate that there will be any space for new students who do not reside within Banta Elementary School District (River Islands is within BESD).**

**All residents of Banta Elementary School District (River Islands is within BESD) along with applicants from outside BESD, must fill out the application for lottery/admission. The application for lottery/admission will be available on the school website January 30<sup>th</sup> - February 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

- Please submit your child's name ***one time only***.
- Kindergarten children must be 5 years old, on or before, September 1, 2019.
- The public random lottery drawing will take place at the school site on February 27, 2019 at 10:00 AM. The public is invited to attend.
- Lottery results will be posted on the website by March 4, 2019.
- **If a student is selected in the lottery, additional paperwork will be required before enrollment is confirmed.**
- When the February lottery has been completed for the projected seats available, the remaining names will be kept for future selection with priority given to residents of the district, which includes River Islands.
